

Open Day events at Wadham

There is no need to book for any of the events on our Open Day, just show up at the Welcome Desk on Parks Road in good time before the start of the event you would like to attend and one of our Student Ambassadors will be happy to direct you. If you are staying in College, feel free to make your way to the rooms yourselves ahead of the start time.

Current undergraduates will be offering short tours of the College throughout the day, including a look at our student accommodation.

9.00-17.00: College Tours: Departing from the Welcome Desk on Parks Road, College tours will be running all day and until 5 pm.

9.00-9.45: Life in College: A chance to listen to some of our current students talk about life as a student at Wadham (Holywell Music Room).

12.45-13.10: Applying to Oxford. Our Tutor for Admissions will give a talk on applying to Oxford in the Holywell Music Room.

13.15-14.00: Meet the Tutors (prospective applicants only). We will be offering the opportunity for prospective applicants to meet with our College tutors. Candidates to meet at the Welcome Desk on Parks Road at 1 pm.

Please note that we will not be offering a tutor session at Wadham for **Oriental Studies**. Visitors interested in subjects offered by this course are welcome to sign up in advance for the Faculty's 'Meet the Tutors' sessions at 10.45am (Oriental Institute, Pusey Lane).

13.15-14.00: Q & A for Parents, Guardians and Teachers. While the tutor sessions are taking place for prospective applicants, we will be running an informal Q&A session for parents, guardians and teachers with Wadham's Tutor for Admissions in the Holywell Music Room. This will include information about finance and welfare provision.

14.10 - 15.00: Demonstration Interviews. Our demonstration interviews will be in a STEM subject in the Moser Theatre, and in a humanities/social science in the Holywell Music Room. Attendance at the demonstration interviews is not limited to those wishing to apply for the specific courses listed; other prospective applicants may find them equally helpful and all are welcome.

15.10 - 15.40: Writing a Personal Statement. Before heading home you may wish to attend our final event for the day, where you can practice and pick up useful tips on how to write a UCAS personal statement (Moser Theatre).
