- You must live in one of Wadham's link areas of Barking and Dagenham, Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Hackney, Havering, Islington, Luton, Newham, Redbridge and Tower Hamlets.
- You must have been eligible for Free School Meals in the last 6 years.

The Access to Banking programme is free. We encourage applications from students taking a range of A Level subjects, including Humanities and Social Sciences; there are no prior subject or knowledge requirements for this programme.
