The Bursaries are partly funded by donations, including from benefactions by Prof Donald Edmonds and Prof Richard Sharpe.

Notes

1. Where the College receives information provided by Student Finance, the Bursaries will be calculated and paid automatically, and recipients informed by email.
2. Other Home and International students will be invited to apply.
3. Bursaries will be paid, in a single sum, as a credit to Battels. This may take place in batches late in MT or HT depending when information is provided.
4. In the event that demand for bursaries is significantly higher than anticipated, the College reserves the right to scale these back to fit available funding.
5. Bursaries apply to the full year, and an adjustment may be made in the event of a change to the license period.
