LICENCE DATES FOR 2024-25 ACADEMIC YEAR

- For Merifield and 11a Lathbury Road: 1st October 2024 10am on 1st July 2025. Students remaining in Oxford during summer, may extend their Merifield licences at a rate of £800/month. Students in some rooms may need to move room for the extended period.
- For Dorothy Wadham Building: 21st/22nd September 2024 10am on 14th/15th June 2025.
- For Main Site: 9th October 2024 10am on 14th June 2025.

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NOTES CONTINUED:

- 1. Fees include utilities, the provision of a network connection and a basic level of personal contents insurance.
- 2. Bed linen and personal linen are not provided. You will need to provide your own duvet and pillow.

PAYMENT OF BATTELS

- 1. Battels are bills for Board and Lodging Charges, and must be settled by the end of the FIRST week of term in Michaelmas and Hilary terms and by the end of 2nd week in Trinity Term, which will include Easter vacation residence charges if applicable. All students transferring monies from overseas should take into account the extra time involved in such transactions.
- 2. Amounts outstanding are liable to incur interest charges at the rate of 0.5% per week, unless alternative arrangements have been agreed with the Domestic Bursar.
- 3. Battels should be paid on-line via the Meal Booking Account or by BACS. Please note that we are unable to accept credit card payments.
- 4. Any battels due after the end of Trinity Term will be sent on and should be paid immediately. However, Finalists must clear their account, including any summer vacation residence charges, by the end of 7th week in Trinity Term.

PAYMENT AND BOOKING OF MEALS

- 1. Payment for breakfast, brunch, lunch and weekend meals is by way of the Bodleian card (known as the 'Bod' card). Breakfast, brunch and lunch are *pay as you go* meals. Students must have credit on their Bod card.
- 2. All those living on the main site will have already been charged and booked in for dinner on weekdays during full term.
- 3. All those not living on the main site (including Dorothy Wadham Building, Merifield and Lathbury Road residents) must sign on, on-line, for dinner during the week by 10 a.m. on the day concerned.
- 4. Those living in College may sign-off for dinner (Monday Friday), on-line, before 10 a.m. on the day concerned and will be credited on their battels, at the pro-rata rate, the following term.

Board and Lodging Charges are revised for the forthcoming year, to take account of known or anticipated increases in costs, in consultation with current students.

The approved charges are published on the accommodation website pages by the end of Trinity Term and all students pay the updated charges from the start of the next academic year.

Board and Lodging Charges have been assessed for the academic year 2024/25 on the best estimates at present available. However, if it becomes apparent that increases in costs exceed estimates to a significant extent, the College reserves the right to increase maintenance charges with effect from Hilary or Trinity Term 2025.
