



Academic-related Grants for Graduate Students Only

1. All subjects - Pollard Grants

Applicants	Graduate students only – all subjects
Purpose	Contribute to course and research related costs, e.g. field trips, conference attendance, research equipment.
Quantity	Max of £ 260 each year while on course, subject to funding. Up to 100% of costs. Multiple applications <u>may</u> be made. Unclaimed grant may carried forward (while still on course), subject to funding. Note – the amount awarded will also depend on the number of applications received, and if applications exceed available funds, then awards will be scaled back, and applicants may receive less than the sum above.
Clarifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May include travel, with support of Advisor. • If spent on books, then College may opt to purchase and place on long loan from the library until completion of course. In such cases, the grant is awarded on condition that the books will not be written in or otherwise marked. • Pollard Fund will provide support to fund Internships only as set out in the general note above. • Pollard Fund will not provide support for fees of academic or professional qualifications.
Applications	While you may apply all year round using the online application form, applications submitted after close of play on Friday of 5th week each term will go to the Loans & Grants Committee meeting in the following term. Each application requires a comment from the relevant College Tutor or Advisor. This is requested by the Finance Bursar’s PA upon receipt of applications.

2. Clinical Medicine - Medical Elective Grants

Applicants	Students in Medicine undertaking their elective.
Purpose	Contribute to cost of elective placements, including travel.
Quantity	Typically up to £ 650. <u>Note:</u> The Medical Society is aware that, according to where you are going, you may well still have a considerable shortfall, and so we have decided to provide up to £300 to each student above the College elective grant. To qualify, you should first have obtained a full College elective grant. When you've done that, please email Stephen Goss setting out concisely your plans and your remaining financial needs and he will arrange for a top-up in consultation with the Society Committee.
Applications	While you may apply all year round using the online application form, applications submitted after close of play on Friday of 5th week each term will go to the Loans & Grants Committee meeting in the following term. Each application requires a comment from the relevant College Tutor or Advisor. This is requested by the Finance Bursar’s PA upon receipt of applications.
