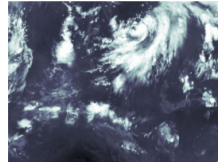
Erasmus Medal for Sir Roger Penrose

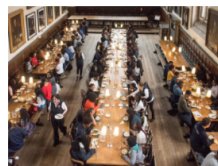
Climate focus
