ii) College Advisor

It is usual to meet your College Advisor at least once a term so that you can discuss your academic progress as well as raise any queries or difficulties. Please make yourself known to your college advisor, either in person at one of the social events at the start of term, or by email.

iii) Graduate Administrator

As well as managing graduate admissions, **Lorena Fierro** supports on-course graduates. She is your first port of call in the Academic Office.
